

## **Project Planning**

### **1. Youth Age Appropriate Relationships**

- Meet with youth groups – separated by gender – to educate on the both the inappropriateness & potential danger of older men in ‘boyfriend’ relationships with young girls
- Educate on the legal impacts of wide age differences in youth sexual relationships
- Reach out to parents to educate concerns – PAC groups representing children/youth age 11 to 18
- Handout material and agenda of forthcoming PAC meeting for youth to take to their families – this may encourage more parents to attend the PAC meeting.

### **2. Youth Sexting**

- Dialog with youth on legal & emotional ramifications of providing and circulating/selling sexually provocative messages and pictures of young people under the age of 18
- Open dialog on potential risks associated with engaging in sexually provocative relationships via electronics.
- ‘Violence is Preventable’ program may offer guidance and education in this area

### **3. Supervision and Support Services for Men**

- We will strive for all police undertakings with no contact orders on men who have been released on a DV charge, to include bail supervision with probation.
- Monitor and support the full use of the Respectful Relationships Program delivered by probation after a conviction of Relationship Violence.
- Develop a program of trained paid or volunteer individuals to support men who have been charged with DV
- Explore means of providing support to all men who want to prevent violence in their relationships
